COGNITIVE APPROACH

(Aaron Beck, Donald Meichenbaum)

Beck's Cognitive Therapy -

- Beliefs are examined according to the "cognitive triad" - views of <u>self</u>, <u>the</u> <u>future</u>, and <u>the world</u>.
- Focus on automatic thoughts, which in turn lead to affective responses
- People make logical errors which lead them to difficulty = cognitive distortions:

Arbitrary inferences Personalization

Overgeneralizations Polarized thinking

Magnification & minimization

Labeling & mislabeling

- Goal of therapy is to restructure underlying "schemata"
- Therapeutic relationship is collaborative
